## **Subfield Content Editor**

APS is currently seeking volunteers to act as Subfield Content Editors. Each position is for a term of one year, with the possibility of renewal.

Editors are responsible for seeking out and posting content related to their specific subfield of research/profession to the APS website (although editors can certainly post any print related content that they find). There are currently five designated subfields, including:

- Old Master prints
- 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> Century prints
- Modern and Contemporary prints
- Studio Printmaking
- Conservation

Editors are encouraged to actively contribute and share content with the APS network by finding any information related to prints that fits into one of the categories on the website, which include: News, Opportunities, and Scholarship. Potential content can be found via websites, email listservs, and other communities of which they are already a part.

The position requires only a minimal time commitment and training. Editors should post a minimum of 3-4 listings a month, but more posts are always welcome!

## Finding Content

### **News**

This category is designed so that members can stay current on events in the print world.

- Art Market (upcoming sales, works at auction, purchases by institution or private collector)
- Awards or Prizes (announcement of a prize's winner)
- Collection (updates related to institutional or private collections)
- Conference or Symposium (announcement that an event is happening, so that people may attend)
- General Announcement (miscellaneous news)
- Lecture (announcement that an event is happening, so that people may attend)
- New Edition (new prints available for purchase)
- Professional (new hires related to the print community)

### **Opportunities**

This category is designated for opportunities members can apply to be considered for.

- Artist Residency
- Call for Papers or Proposals
- Curatorial Opportunity
- Exhibition Participation
- Fellowship or Grant
- Internship
- Job
- Workshop

### **Scholarship**

Generally, this category is for members to publicize their own publications, but you are welcome to post significant new scholarship. If the author/curator is an APS member, you can tag them in the post. To do so, select "yes" under the field "Is the Author an APS Member?" Next, search for the member's name in the "Author" field.
